Local newspapers recently published an article titled “Swim Team Parents Examine Pool Board.” The Charlevoix Area Community Pool (CACP) board would like to offer some clarification to this article.

The CACP Board is negotiating with the new Recreational Authority to continue the smooth pathway for millage money to flow to CACP. Everyone can be assured that the CACP has never misappropriated any tax millage funds, and the intentions of the voters, as embodied in the millage measure, have always been followed.

Northern Michigan is faced with unprecedented shortages of qualified workers, a problem that has affected the pool as well. Although the CACP Board has invested considerable time and effort into the recruitment of a new swim team coach, the board has yet to be successful. However, the board remains focused on this vital position and is continuing its active search for a swim team coach.

The CACP is a 501c3 non-profit organization. It is governed by an all-volunteer Board of Directors, made up of community members from various backgrounds who bring their expertise to the board.
