GROUP SWIM LESSON INFORMATION from the Charlevoix Area Community Pool

A limited number of group swim lesson scholarships are available in 2023-24 to students from any school district in Charlevoix and Emmet Counties. The scholarship includes one set of group lessons plus four pool visit vouchers for the student to practice their swim lesson skills during open swim times. Scholarships will be awarded to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch according to Federal guidelines. Please ask us for information if you are not sure your child qualifies for a scholarship.

Parents or Guardians of students applying for scholarships will need to fill out this form and bring it to the pool for review before a swim lesson session starts. If scholarships are still available, and the student qualifies for a scholarship, the parent or guardian will be notified by phone. The pool will not be able to provide any transportation to or from the pool. The student is required to attend ALL swim lessons in the session. These scholarships are awarded on a first come/first served basis so we recommend getting your form in early so the pool staff can determine the child's eligibility.
